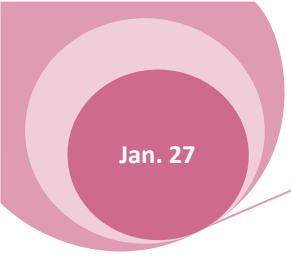

Even as we look back and review our accomplishments in 2013 we know that 2014 is going to be a significant year in the library’s history as we undertake a renovation project and re-commit to community engagement.

**Hours** 🖱

The library provided 50 service hours per week.

**Visits**

The number of visits to the library was consistent with 2012. Door count numbers continue to be an approximation. The addition of new generation people counters would result in more accurate statistics.

**Patrons**

**Computer Usage** 🖱

19,134 uses of the computers were recorded in 2013 .The library has 17 patron computers linked to the internet, 1 early childhood computer, and one dedicated catalog computer. Two flatbed scanners are available for use by the public. There were 2,316 registered WiFi sessions from June-December. This number is generated by the authentication software SPOT which was installed June, 2013.



**Collection Development Expenditures**

15.9% of operating fund expenditures was spent on collection development including databases and ebooks.

(Standards Note 7.5% Basic, 15% Enhanced, 20% Exceptional)

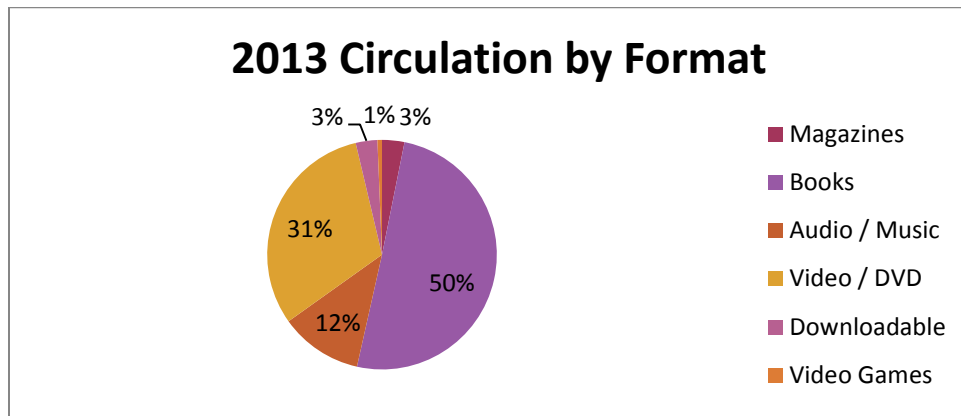

Collection Turnover rates are calculated by looking at the total circulation for a specific shelving location and dividing that by the number of items in that location. For example Area A may have 100 items, with 50 circulations recorded. This would result in a collection turnover rate of 0.5. If Area A recorded 200 circulations the turnover rate would be 2.
